٨	<ul> <li>UIRED: Pre-solo aeronautical knowledge exam [§61.87(b)] {A.3}</li> <li>Pass (correctable to 100%) pre-solo exam issued by your instructor</li> <li>Exam knowledge areas:</li> <li>Applicable sections of FAR parts 61 and 91</li> <li>Airspace rules and procedures for Green Castle airport where the solo flight will be conducted</li> <li>Flight characteristics and operational limitations of the aircraft to be flown</li> </ul>
AAA	<ul> <li>UIRED: Pre-solo flight training: Maneuvers &amp; procedures [§61.87(c) &amp; (d)] {A.4}</li> <li>Flight preparation procedures: Preflight planning &amp; preparation, powerplant operation, and aircraft systems</li> <li>Surface operations: Taxiing &amp; runups</li> <li>Flight Fundamentals: <ul> <li>Straight &amp; level flight, turns, climbs &amp; descents, and turning climbs &amp; descents (various configurations)</li> <li>Flight at various airspeeds from cruise to slow flight</li> </ul> </li> <li>Traffic Patterns &amp; Landings <ul> <li>Traffic patterns, including entry and departure procedures</li> <li>Normal &amp; crosswind takeoffs and landings</li> <li>Slips to land &amp; go-arounds</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
